NOVENA TO IMMACULATE CONCEPTION: We will begin a Novena to the Immaculate Conception on 29<sup>th</sup> Nov. until 8<sup>th</sup> December. Archbishop George will start the Novena and end it with the celebration of Holy Mass and a parish gettogether on 8<sup>th</sup>.
