Amen.

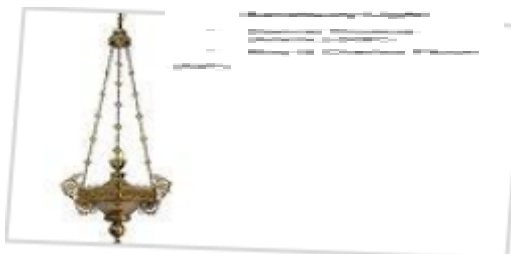
